Eligibility and Award Information



Academic Scholarships

Title: Presidential Honor Scholarship

Objective: Presidential Honor Scholarships are awarded to those individuals who display the ultimate academic potential as demonstrated by their previous academic performance.

Academic Programs: UAT Undergraduate programs with normal program length of 4 semesters (Associate's only) or 8 semesters (Bachelor only).

Scholarship Value: Up to \$2000.00 applied to tuition equally over each semester in each academic year. Scholarship is awarded upon enrollment and subject to renewal conditions.

Conditions: Applicant must meet all admissions requirements, enroll and start an Undergraduate program at the University of Advancing for a scholarship to be awarded. Presidential Honor Scholarships may be renewed each academic year for up to four (4) academic years provided the recipient maintains at least a 3.0 CGPA.

Basis for selection: Selection shall be based on previous academic achievement as follows. Academic performance minimums are determined annually and published in the University's Academic Catalog.

Academic Qualifications for this award in the current UAT Academic Catalog are as follows:

- High School CGPA of 3.85 or greater
- SAT score of 1542 or greater
- GED score of 770 or greater
- ACT score of 35 or greater
- College CGPA of 3.8 or higher (for those admitted based on a College Degree only)

(Qualification criteria subject to change based upon catalog/addendum of admission for student)

Title: Deans Award Scholarship

Objective: Deans Award Scholarships are awarded to those individuals who display academic potential as demonstrated by their previous academic performance.

Academic Programs: UAT Undergraduate programs with normal program lengths of 4 semesters (Associates only) or 8 semesters (Bachelor only).

Scholarship Value: Up to \$1000.00 applied to tuition equally over each semester in each academic year. Scholarship is awarded upon enrollment and subject to renewal conditions.

Conditions: Applicant must meet all admissions requirements, enroll and start an Undergraduate program at the University of Advancing Technology for a scholarship to be awarded. Presidential Honor Scholarships may be renewed each academic year for up to four (4) academic years provided the recipient maintains at least a 3.0 CGPA.

- SAT score of 1445 or greater
- GED score of 720 or greater
- ACT score of 31 or greater
- College CGPA of 3.47 or higher (for those admitted based on a College Degree only)

(Qualification criteria subject to change based upon catalog/addendum of admission for student)

Title: Scholars Award

Objective: Scholars Award Scholarships are awarded to those individuals who display the ultimate academic potential as demonstrated by their previous academic performance.

Academic Programs: UAT Undergraduate programs with normal program lengths of 4 semesters (Associates only) or 8 semesters (Bachelor only).

Scholarship Value: Up to \$750.00 applied to tuition equally over each semester in each academic year. Scholarship is awarded upon enrollment and subject to renewal conditions.

Conditions: Applicant must meet all admissions requirements, enroll and start an Undergraduate program at the University of Advancing Technology for a scholarship to be awarded. Presidential Honor Scholarships may be renewed each academic year for up to four (4) academic years provided the recipient maintains at least a 3.0 CGPA.

Basis for selection:

Selection shall be based on previous academic achievement as follows. Academic performance minimums are determined annually and published in the University's Academic Catalog. Academic Qualifications for this award in the current UAT Academic Catalog are as follows:

- High School CGPA of 3.4 or greater
- SAT score of 1368 or greater
- GED score of 680 or greater
- ACT score of 30 or greater
- College CGPA of 3.2 or higher (for those admitted based on a College Degree only)

(Qualification criteria subject to change based upon catalog/addendum of admission for student)

Please note that applications are not required for Academic Scholarships. These scholarships will be provisionally awarded to those who meet the requirements listed above on their applications. It is the responsibility of the incoming student to provide the University with official records supporting the award of the scholarship by the submission deadline.

Advancing technology Awards of up to \$750.00 per academic year are awarded to students upon initially entering the University of Advancing Technology and may be renewed each academic year for up to four (4) academic years provided the recipient maintains at least a 3.0 CGPA.
